The Interfaith Walk took place on Saturday 14 April and was a great success. 33 people completed the whole walk (over 20,000 steps and about 10 miles) and over 100 people did a part of the walk. The route took in the Fazl London Mosque, The Wimbledon Synagogue, The Apostolic Nunciature to Great Britain, The Buddhapadipa Temple, St Mary's Wimbledon and the Shree Ganapathy Temple. The participants were warmly welcomed at each venue, tours or talks were given, refreshments offered and questions answered. Over £600 was raised for Merton Faith in Action. There are plans to do another Interfaith Walk next year using a different route.
